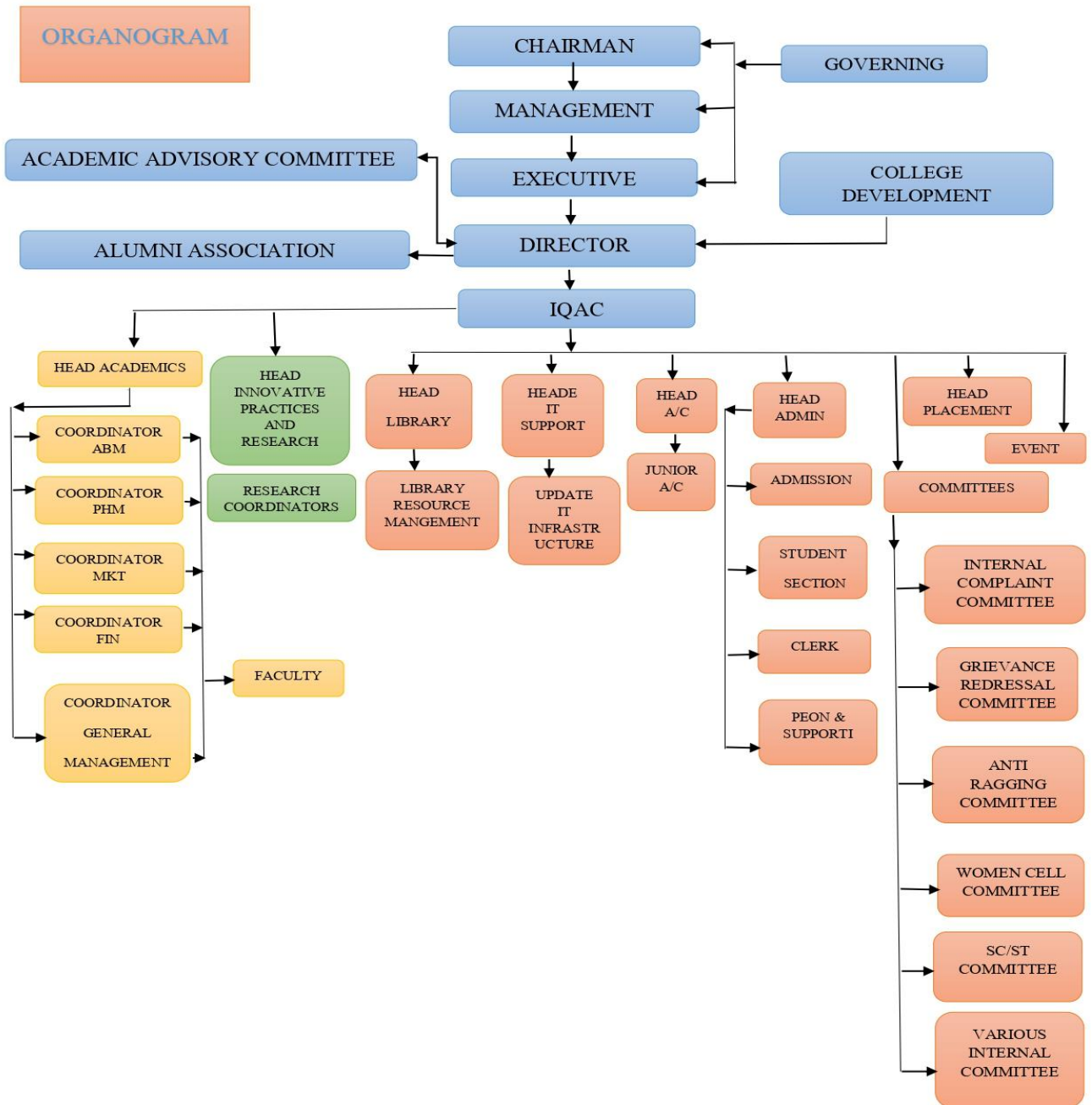

- The Governing Council approves **budgetary allocations** towards infrastructure, staffing, and **Research & Development (R&D)**.
- The **Chairperson** is responsible for leading the Governing Body and ensuring its effectiveness. The Chairperson ensures that the institution is well connected with stakeholders.
- The Chairperson supports the **Head of the Institution** in the execution of programs.
- The Governing Council meets **at least two times a year or whenever required**.

## **Nature and Extent of Involvement of Faculty and Students in Academic Affairs / Improvements**

## **Mechanism / Norms and Procedure for Democratic / Good Governance**

The Governing Council exercises powers and discharges the following functions:

- Ensures proper management, maintenance, and custody of the institution in relation to land, infrastructure, equipment, and funds, including loans and grants received from AICTE, Central Government, and Government of Maharashtra.
- Ensures that the campus is maintained in good condition.
- Ensures that instructions are imparted in accordance with the norms and standards prescribed by the Government of Maharashtra and SPPU.
- Ensures approval of staff appointments through the selection committee of the institute in accordance with the norms prescribed by AICTE and the Government of Maharashtra.
- Ensures implementation of provisions, acts, instructions, rules, and regulations prescribed by AICTE and the Government of Maharashtra in matters related to service conditions of staff, including appointment, leave, Provident Fund, age of retirement, and disciplinary actions.
- Ensures observance and compliance of instructions issued by AICTE, Government of Maharashtra, and the affiliating University.
- Ensures that the building, land, furniture, and facilities are not used for any purpose other than running AICTE-approved courses (such as political or communal meetings).
- Submits reports and returns from time to time to AICTE, Government of Maharashtra, and the affiliating University.
- Creates a peaceful and favorable atmosphere for study, free from ragging.

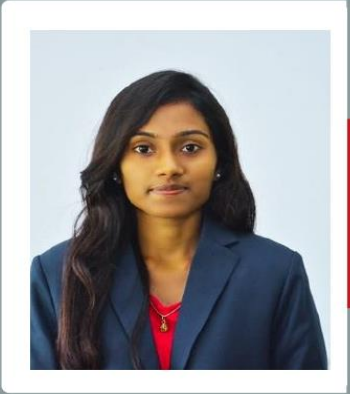
